Highlights from our Week:

- **Math:** 4th graders began wrapping up their unit on multiplying larger multidigit numbers using several strategies. The 3rd graders focused on graphing this week, as well as multiplication review.
- Social Studies: We practiced for our map vocabulary quiz next week.
- **Religion:** We began our study of the Jesse Tree! We painted our own Jesse Trees. During this unit, we will read a beautiful story of the Jesse Tree and meet all of Jesus' ancestors in the Bible.
