## **Highlights from our Week:**

- Math: Both grade levels wrapped up unit 5 and took their tests on Tuesday. On Wednesday they began unit 6! The 3<sup>rd</sup> graders are studying geometry now and the 4<sup>th</sup> graders are working on multiplication and division of multi-digit numbers.
