# Live Simply so Others May Simply Live:

Embracing a Sustainable and Spirit-filled Lifestyle for Advent/Christmas

The first Christmas took place in a very simple setting—a stable. As we prepare to celebrate the birth of Jesus, we are challenged to remember its humility and simplicity.

The Caring for Creation Committee invites us to live simply and sustainably this season, to focus on what truly brings peace and joy on this feast of God-becoming-human.

#### Reflection:

Last year we spent December in Europe. Looking at other traditions, perhaps we can "simplify" our Christmas traditions.

In **Germany**, St. Nicholas is celebrated on Dec. 6 when children receive a small gift in their shoe left out the night before. Families celebrate Christmas on Dec. 25, focused on dinner, baking and spending time together. Presents are not the focus since St. Nicholas came on Dec. 6.

In **The Netherlands**, children also put out their shoes the night of Dec. 5; Sinterklaas leaves treats and small gifts. The tradition of Sinterklaas is a time to come together to sing songs and indulge in sweets.

In the spirit of St. Nicholas, can we simplify by finding charities or organizations to "gift" needy people with Christmas meals, winter clothing and toys for children instead of gifts for your family.

Simplify. Find ways of "gifting" family-time presents like snowshoeing in the forest or an escape to a B-N-B to watch winter storms and play games together.

Focus Christmas Day on time together as family, like the "Holy Family". Prepare meals together, share stories of Christmas. Choose to Celebrate Simply.


