Reflections from El Salvador



Six parishioners recently visited our Sister Community in the Bajo Lempa region of El Salvador. Each delegate will share a reflection of their experiences.

El Salvador: A Profound Experience

For several years, God had been putting it on my heart to travel to El Salvador with the St. Aloysius Delegation. This was significant because I had never wanted to travel outside of the United States and Canada. I can truthfully say that this trip has been one of the most profound experiences of my life.

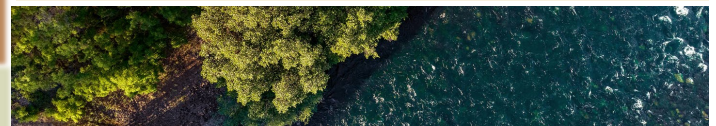
We went to El Salvador to be in solidarity with the people of our Sister Community. It was humbling to know that the people were so grateful that we were there to hear their stories. They only asked that we share their stories when we returned home. I felt like our hearts connected.

As the mother of an incarcerated son, I felt a kinship with the mothers whose sons were arrested due to the "state of exception." However, my heart was broken to hear that their sons were completely innocent and that these mothers and families have had no contact with their sons for 22 months and have no right to get any information about them, even to know if they are dead or alive. I pray God will never let me forget these wonderful people and their stories.

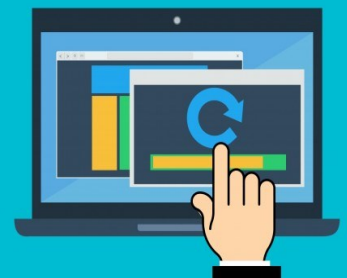

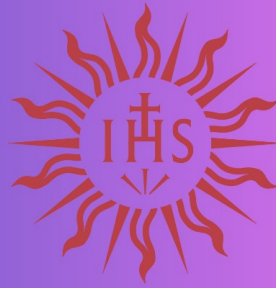
