Message From the Co-Principals

Dear Families,

Today at Monday Morning Prayer, we reflected on what we were grateful for this Lenten Season. I was able to share how thankful I was that Christ was willing to die on the cross for me so that my sins could be forgiven, and I could be offered the gift of salvation. When I fully understood what this meant, it became a defining moment in my faith journey. I began to focus less on my unworthiness and instead on why I was worthy. Christ's unconditional love truly heals people in ways we could never imagine. This was also the main message the Catholic speaker shared with us at our inservice last Friday. It was a day centered on faith formation, giving us time to pause and reflect on God's transformational power in our lives.

- **Tomorrow, March 12:** You will receive an email that provides you with steps for registering for the 2024-25 school year.
- Important Information: On March 12, FACTS will turn on our new Premier Integration, and families will lose the ability to login to their FACTS payment plan. Moving forward, all families will access their payment plan through the FACTS Family Portal.
- If your account is not current, you will be unable to register in FACTS until it is paid in full.
